This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as 'MOU') is made on 15 Dec 17

Between

Research Cell, Pratibha Institute of Business Management situated at Block D-III, Plot no 3, Behind Mehta Hospital, Chinchwad, Pune -19 (hereinafter referred to as "PIBM")

And

Post Graduate Research Centre, S. B. Patil Institute of Management, situated at Sector No. 26, Near Akurdi Railway Station, Pradhikaran, Nigdi, Pune-44 (hereinafter referred to as "SBPIM")

Whereas,

- A. PIBM and SBPIM wish to develop academic exchanges and cooperation in teaching and research in furtherance of the advancement and dissemination of learning.
- B. PIBM and SBPIM wish to co-operate to promote, facilitate and implement co-operation in the following programs and activities:

Now it is hereby agreed as follows:

Areas of Cooperation:


PIBM and SBPIM agree to the following goals and objectives in order to initiate the academic collaboration programme:

a) Campus Visit

PIBM and SBPIM shall allow research students of their respective institutes to visit their campuses in the format of institute visits (one day visit with an orientation tour and faculty session)

b) Joint Research and Consultancy

PIBM and SBPIM will work together on joint research and consultancy projects in specific areas of mutual interest. For this purpose, expenditure incurred at respective institutes will be borne by each Institute. The revenue generated through these projects will be shared equally among the two institutes. The scope of this MOU shall not be



limited and applicable only for below mentioned points but any other points mutually discussed and agreed upon:

- **Joint Research Paper:** Faculties from both PIBM and SBPIM will work together for writing research paper, conducting live research projects, funded research projects by the various funding agencies e.g. University, UGC, AICTE, Pvt Organizations, Govt. Organizations etc and all other related research activities.
- **Student Guidance:** Faculties from both PIBM and SBPIM will provide cross Institutional guidance to the students associated with research activities in the research cell of both the Institutes. This assistance will include guidance during Summer Internship Project, Live Research Project, Doctoral Research and all other related activities.
- **Library Sharing:** Faculties and students from both PIBM and SBPIM will have free access to the library and related infrastructure of both the Institutes . Party Institutes on a prior notice will provide full access to library facility of the other Institute for research related work. Library staff from both the Institutes will conduct regular meetings for exchange of knowledge transfer on latest journals, magazines, databases and developments in library science. The process and policy for accessing study material shall be mutually agreed by the party Institutes.
- **Designing and Conducting Course work:** Faculties from both PIBM and SBPIM will jointly design and conduct the subject specified course work of regular doctoral programme. Party Institutes will also develop study material for the said course work.
- **Training on Tools:** Faculties from both PIBM and SBPIM will jointly have training for analytical tools (SPSS , SAS) for students of party Institutes and other Institutes as well.

c) **Knowledge Transfer (Teaching)**

Faculties from both the Institutes will engage in recourse sharing for knowledge transfer for a period mutually decided upon by the two Institutes and contribute in the form of teaching certain modules or topics in an identified course. This in turn will enable the creation of innovative pedagogy which in turn will benefit the students.



d) Creating awareness about various programmes offered by both the Institutes

PIBM and SBPIM will exchange the resources, they have with each other for publicizing the information about programmes, functions, seminars, workshops and symposiums offered by both the Institutes. Faculties from both the Institutes will attend FDP and Refresher Courses organized by both the Institutes in areas of mutual interest.

e) Student Exchange

PIBM and SBPIM will extend their resources for 'Student Exchange' programmes. Under this programme, students from one Institute can opt for a week of learning at the other Institute. The attendance and concurrent evaluation can be shared with the parent Institute.

f) Training for Students and Faculties

PIBM and SBPIM will design and impart need based training programmes for students and faculties of both the Institutes. A joint certificate will be awarded on successful completion of the training. A pre-decided fee can be charged, which can be charged from time to time.

Duration and Termination Clause:

The duration of this MOU will be for the period of three years. The MOU can be extended for further period with the same or mutually agreed terms. PIBM and SBPIM retain the right to terminate this MOU after one year from the date of it's signing.
