#### Step 3: Action Taken:

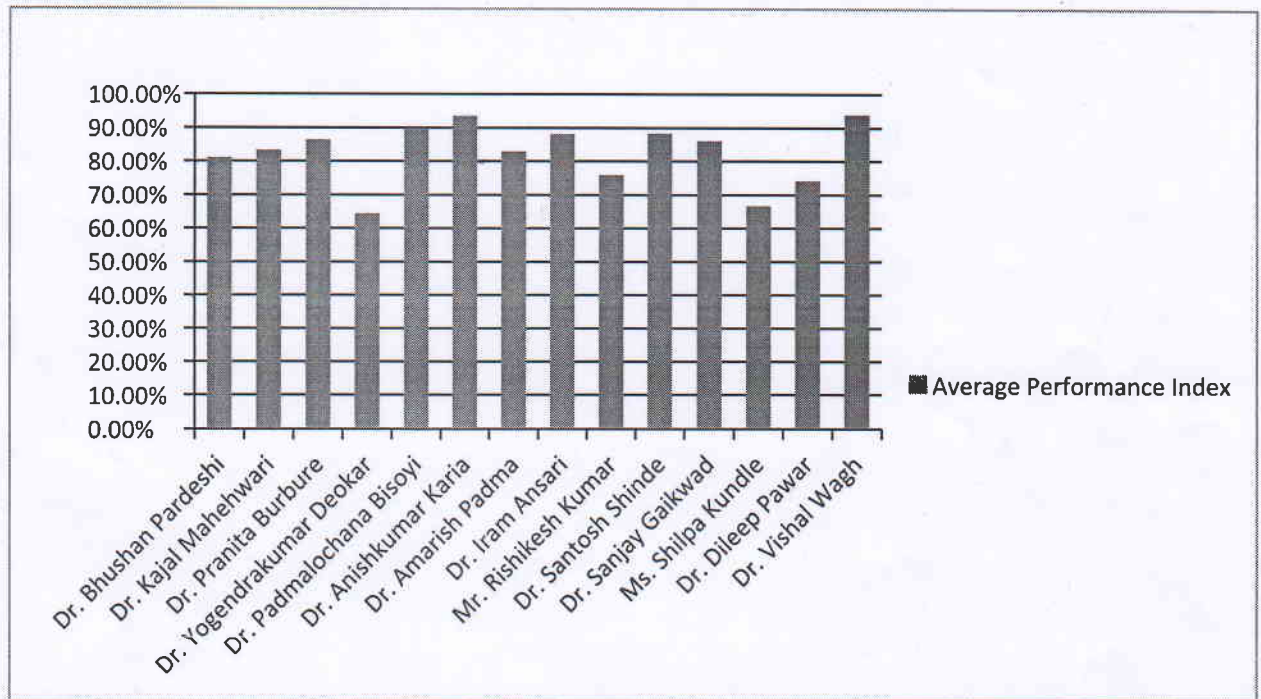
The reports are discussed in confidential with the individual faculty members and necessary instructions are given for further scope of action towards improvement and up gradation.
