Our epics and historical texts are rife with important lessons that can help us greatly in life.

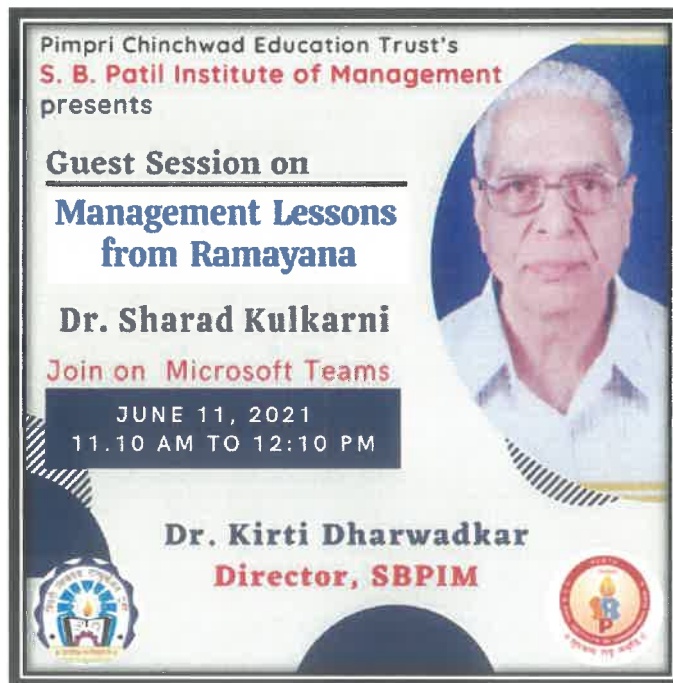

14. Coolness In Adversity

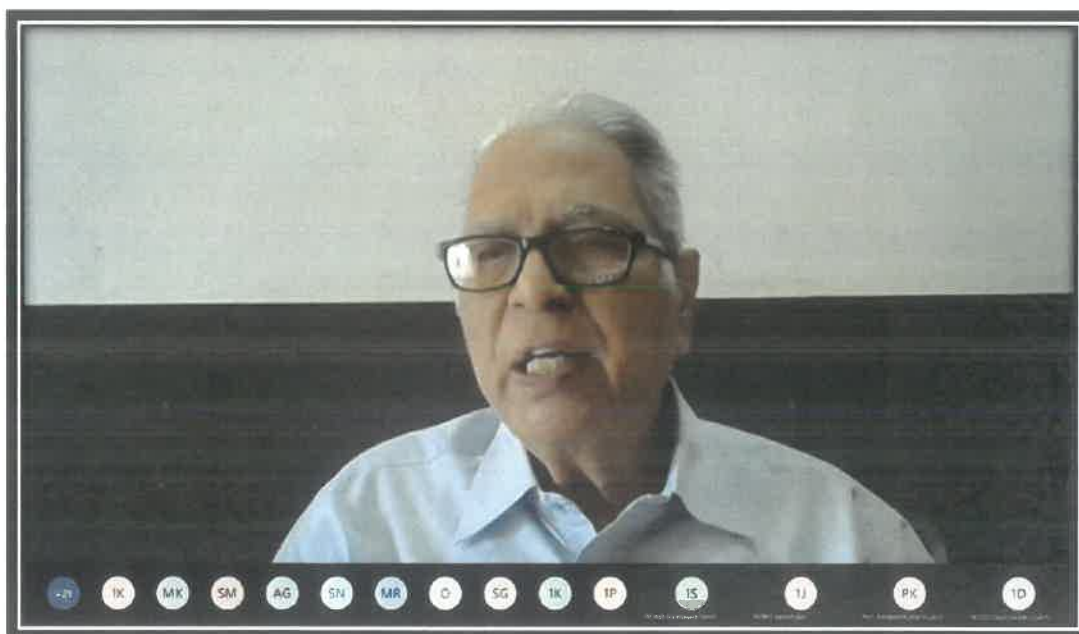
Even at fourteen, these are only a few of the lessons in management you can gain from the Ramayana. If you read the entire work, every line will teach you something that you can apply when managing your company.
