



Mechanism for Feedback from Stakeholders on Curriculum

Institute in each academic year collects feedback on curriculum from stakeholders - Students, Teachers, Parents, Alumni and Employers. The feedback on curriculum provided by stakeholders gives insights to enhance quality of education.

Feedback Process:

- **Stage I (Collection of Feedback)**
 - Structured Feedback Forms filled and submitted throughout the year from stakeholder.
 - The feedback from are collected via online/offline methods.
- **Stage II (Analysis of Feedback)**
 - HoD Academics prepares the Feedback Analysis Report at the end of every academic year.
 - Feedback Analysis Report is prepared based on the consolidated inputs of all stakeholders and suggestions / points mentioned by them in feedback form.
- **Stage III (Communication & Corrective Measures)**
 - Feedback analysis is communicated to Director, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) by HoD Academics.
 - Corrective measures are taken to improve quality of education.
 - The summarized analysis and suggestions are communicated to University Board of Studies Chairman & Members in intervals.
- **Stage IV (Display)**
 - Display of Feedback Analysis Report and Action Taken Report on Institute Website.
