Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi said about the Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav that the celebrations for India's 75 years of Independence should reflect the spirit of the country's freedom movement and showcase its achievements to the world since 1947.

The Indian independence movement was a series of historic events with the ultimate aim of ending the British rule in India. The movement spanned from 1857 to 1947.

The first nationalistic revolutionary movement for Indian independence emerged from Bengal. It later took root in the newly formed Indian National Congress with prominent moderate leaders seeking only their fundamental right to appear for Indian Civil Service examinations in British India, as well as more rights (economical in nature) for the people of the soil.

S. B. Patil Institute of Management invited Mr. Sagar Magar, Asst Prof, Department of History, Savitribai Phule Pune University to share his knowledge on the topic "India's Freedom Fight".

Mr. Sagar talked about the stages of freedom struggles including the revolt of 1857, formation of Indian National Congress, rise of Extremist Leaders and Gandhian Movements. He also explained about the principles adopted by Non Violent Constitution Movement, participation of masses and also the reaction to this movement.

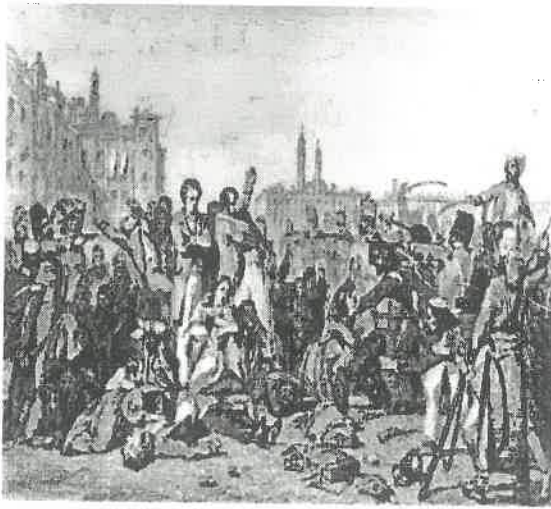

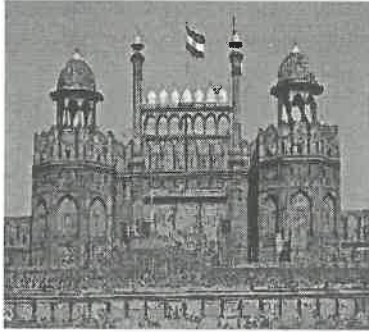
