

This **Memorandum of Understanding** is intended to promote international collaboration and cooperation between SBPIM, Pune and DYPIMS, Pune, India.



SBPIM represented by **Prof. Dr.Kirti Dharwadkar** and **DYPIMS** represented by **Prof Dr Ashutosh Misal**, recognizing the benefits to their respective Institutes hereby agree to enter into this agreement for the following purposes:

A. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic cooperation to establish collaborative activities in Faculty & Students Exchange, Conference Partnership, Publication, Information Sharing etc between the two institutes/ universities and to cooperate in their mutual interest for a range of higher educational activities.

B. AREAS OF COOPERATION

Subject to the availability of funds, resources and approval of the authorized representatives or heads of SBPIM and DYPIMS or Authorities signing the MoU, both institutions agree to develop the following collaborative activities:

- a. Exchange of Faculty Members
- b. Exchange of Students
- c. Organizing of International Conference, Guest Sessions, Seminars, HR Meets, Symposia and Workshops jointly
- d. Carrying out minor Research Projects jointly by faculty members and students
- e. Sharing of Syllabus as an add on input to the existing students enrolled with respective institutes
- f. Joint release of Research Papers, Journals, Publications etc
- g. Exchanging of information such as study material, research findings and publications, monograms, intellectual property, patents, ED cell, NSS, etc
- h. Searching for Opportunities for Collaboration in Future.
- i. Joint ISR (Institute Social Responsibility) activities.
- j. Joint ED (Entrepreneurship Development) cell activities.

C. IMPLEMENTATION

- a. All programs or activities implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the necessary budget for the program of activity as the need may arise time to time.
- b. Each of the participating institutions shall be fully responsible financially for the activities carried out under its direction or by its staff, except as otherwise agreed by the parties.
- c. The parties will designate one officer each who will develop and coordinate specific programs or activities between them.

D. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Both partner institutions shall ensure that any results and publications originating from the collaboration will be available with both Institutes in India and (Country of Institute)

E. DURATION AND RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT

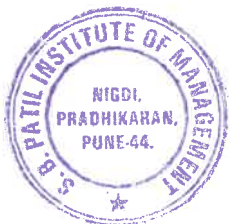
The MoU shall be effective immediately after signatures by the representatives of both the Institutes for a period of 5 years and is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement.

F. AMENDMENTS

- a. The MoU may be amended by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both Institutes.
- b. In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities in either country both Institutes agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution.
- c. Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation or implementation of the agreement, the Institutes shall endeavor to exercise best efforts to negotiate their differences.

G. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

This agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either party upon prior notice to the other in writing before the agreed-upon termination date, provided that such termination shall not affect the completion of any program or activity underway at the time the notice of termination.
