## About Young Indians (Yi)

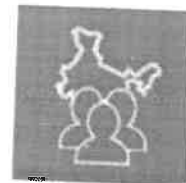

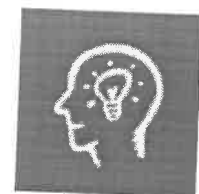

## Y20 Engagement Group with Yi

Young Indians in collaboration with Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports is planning to host brainstorming sessions across the country in prominent institutions to facilitate an outcome based discussions. The Youth20 engagement group with Young Indians shall have the sessions on following themes

- (1) A dialogue between young Indian achievers and governance institutions of urban and rural local bodies on participatory models of governance;
