Report:

S. B. Patil Institute of Management organized a session on “SAFTEY OF WOMEN WITH RISING CYBER CRIMES” considering the importance of the topic via micro soft team’s platform. The session was delivered by Mr. MAHESH RAKHEJA, Cyber Security Consultant and Technical Public Speaker. All the ladies staff members and the Girl students of MBA -I & II year were present online for the session.

The session started with a welcome speech given by Miss. AANCHAL SINGH from MBA I year. She welcomed Mr. MAHESH RAKHEJA SIR and all the ladies who joined via MS. TEAMS platform. She explained why the session on “CYBER SECURITY” is important for girls.

Mr. Rakesh Raheja, explained that how the cyber crime is increasing and why it is important for ladies to be more careful while handling their social media accounts. He emphasized on BIG DATA and explained how data gets manipulated and also how to use social networking website. He explained with various examples that the mobile is not secure to share the confidential information. He said that “WE ARE HACKED ALREADY” and that our passwords are already known to the hackers. People should avoid using phones which could be easily hacked. He also

advised not to click on private pictures and not to keep the private information in one's phone. He informed that the mobile camera continues to click pictures, snapshots, and hence should be aware and should learn how and where to use the phone. He gave an example of a Nagpur girl, a victim of cybercrime case whose phone was hacked and how she faced problem. He said that anything in our mobile is exposed to hacker and it can create problem in real life. So be aware whatever is happening in surrounding specially on internet.

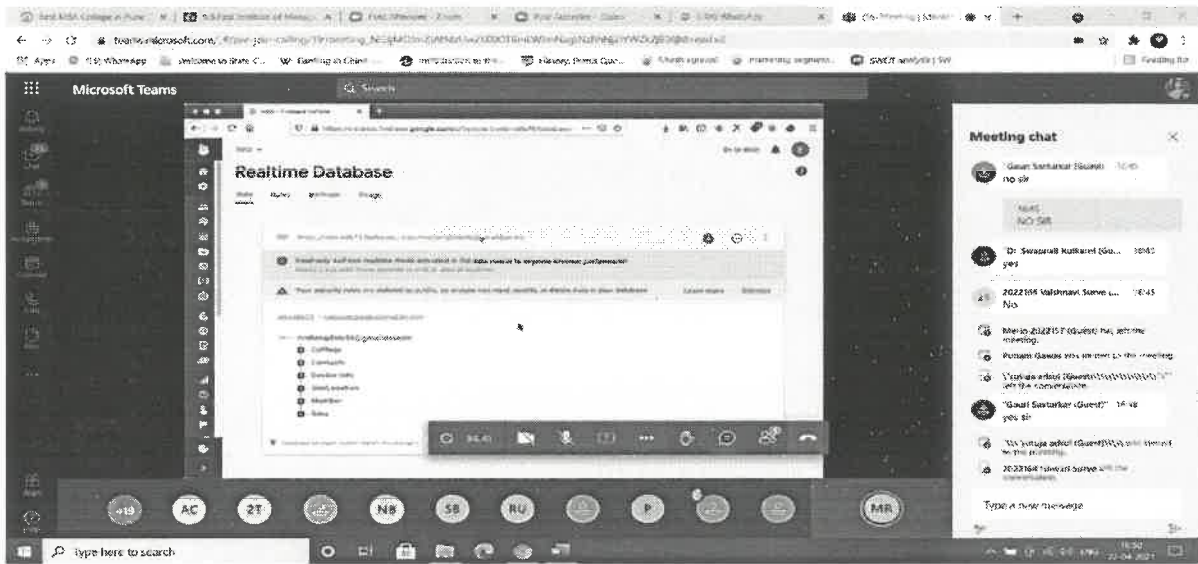

**Session on “Historical Monuments in Pune”**

1<sup>st</sup> April 2021

India is one of the most beautiful countries in the world and is best known for its colourful culture and fascinating heritage. Its grand monuments, like the Taj Mahal act as strong pillars of the rich and deep history that India possesses. From their splendid architecture to a strong legacy, the historical monuments of India speak volumes. Most of these Indian monuments were primarily built under the regime of Rajputana, Dravidian and Mughal emperors. The monuments of India are speaking stones of the glory of its rulers and the brilliance of artisans in ancient India. Due to the incredible beauty of India and the constant efforts of the government in maintaining the heritage sites, India tourism has flourished rapidly witnessing an increase in the number of travellers from all around the world. Some of the well-preserved monuments in the different parts of the country are Red Fort (North), Sun Temple Konark (East), Amer Fort (West) and Charminar (South).

Pune is one of the most important historical cities in Maharashtra. It was the hub of Maratha rulers and subsequently, the British. The city is home to hundreds of monuments and historical structures, some of which are thousands of years old, and they include forts, palaces, buildings and even temples. Each historic spot of Pune has inspiring and interesting stories to narrate. The historic places and monuments in Pune consist of Shaniwar wada, Lal Mahal, Aga Khan Palace, Sinhgad fort and many more.

S. B. Patil Institute of Management conducted a session on “Historical Monuments in Pune” for the students of MBA. Dr. Amarish Padma discussed about the various monument sin Pune. He explained about the state protected monumnets as Raigad, Sinhgad, Koirigad, Mahatma Phule Vada. He explained Sinhgad fort in detail. He said that Sinhagad is a hill fortress located at around 35 km southwest of the city of Pune, India. Some of the information available at this fort suggests that the fort could have been built 2000 years ago. The caves and the carvings in the Kaundinyeshwar temple stand as proofs for the same.

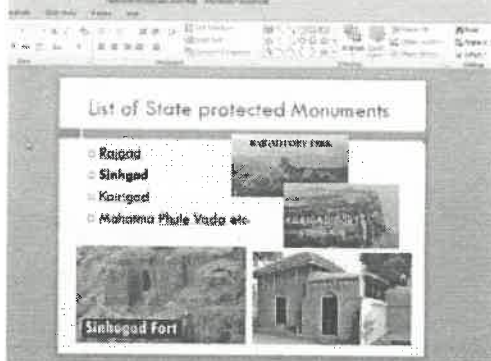
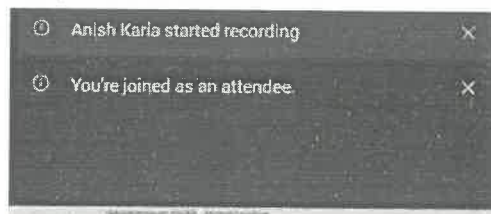
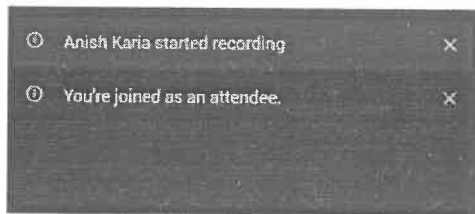
Dr. Padma explained as to why Sinhgad is so important and told that previously it was known as Kondhana, the fort had been the site of many battles, most notably the Battle of Sinhagad in



1670. Perched on an isolated cliff of the Bhuleswar range in the Sahyadri Mountains, the fort is situated on a hill about 760 metres above ground and 1,312 metres above mean sea level.[citation needed]

Dr. Amrish said that Sinhagad (Lion's Fort) was strategically built to provide natural protection due to its very steep slopes. The walls and bastions were constructed only at key places. There are two gates to enter the fort, the Kalyan Darwaza and Pune Darwaza which are positioned at the south east and north-east ends respectively. The fort was also strategically located at the centre of a string of other Maratha Empire forts such as Rajgad Fort, Purandar Fort and Torna Fort. He ended his session with saying that these monuments are of great importance to us and should be preserved, which is our responsibility.

### Why Sinhgad is so important?


- Anyone who controlled the fort also dominated the strategic route from Pune down to the Konkan coast.
- Strategically located at the centre of a string of other Maratha Empire forts such as Raigad Fort, Parandur Fort and Torna Fort.
- Used to tackle any aggression coming from northern side into their territory which means if an army coming from north towards swarajya (Konkan predominantly) you could face/fight them there.

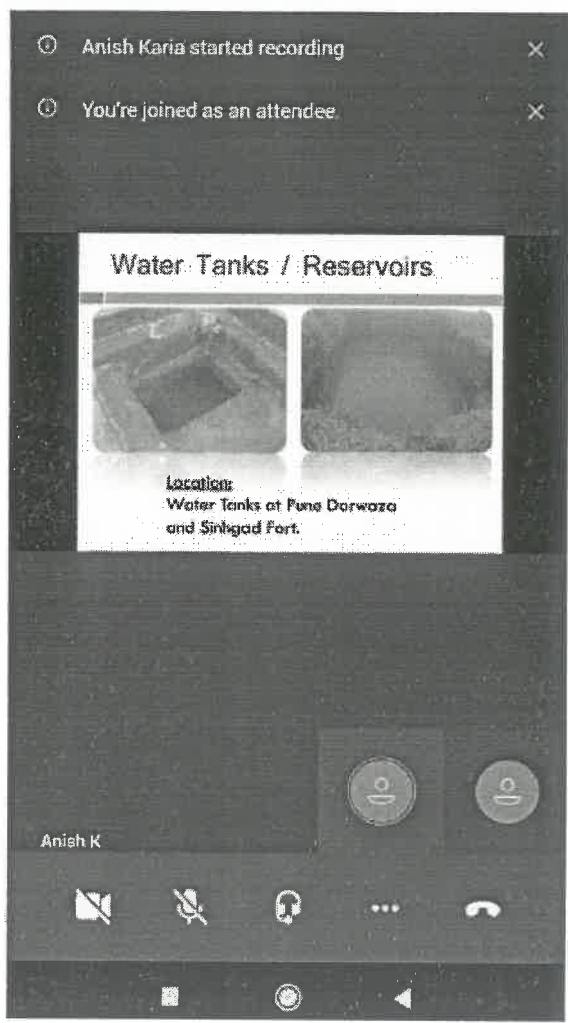
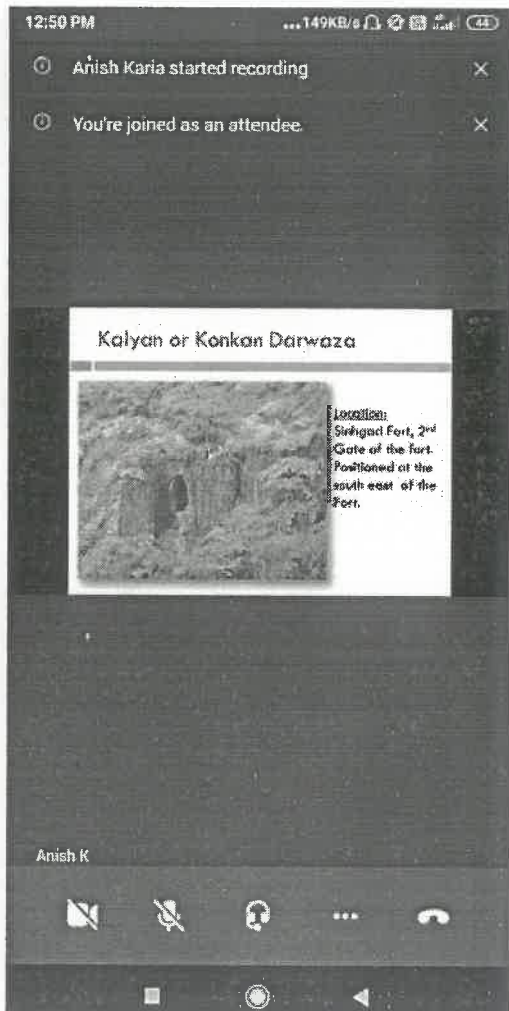
### Pune or Donje Darwaza

### Session on "Indian Constitution"

1<sup>st</sup> April 2021

The Constitution of India is the supreme law of India. The document lays down the framework that demarcates fundamental political code, structure, procedures, powers, and duties of government institutions and sets out fundamental rights, directive principles, and the duties of citizens. It is the longest written constitution of any country on earth.

It imparts constitutional supremacy (not parliamentary supremacy, since it was created by a constituent assembly rather than Parliament) and was adopted by its people with a declaration in its preamble. Parliament cannot override the constitution.

It was adopted by the Constituent Assembly of India on 26 November 1949 and became effective on 26 January 1950. The constitution replaced the Government of India Act 1935 as the country's fundamental governing document, and the Dominion of India became the Republic of India. To ensure constitutional autochthony, its framers repealed prior acts of the British parliament in Article 395. India celebrates its constitution on 26 January as Republic Day.

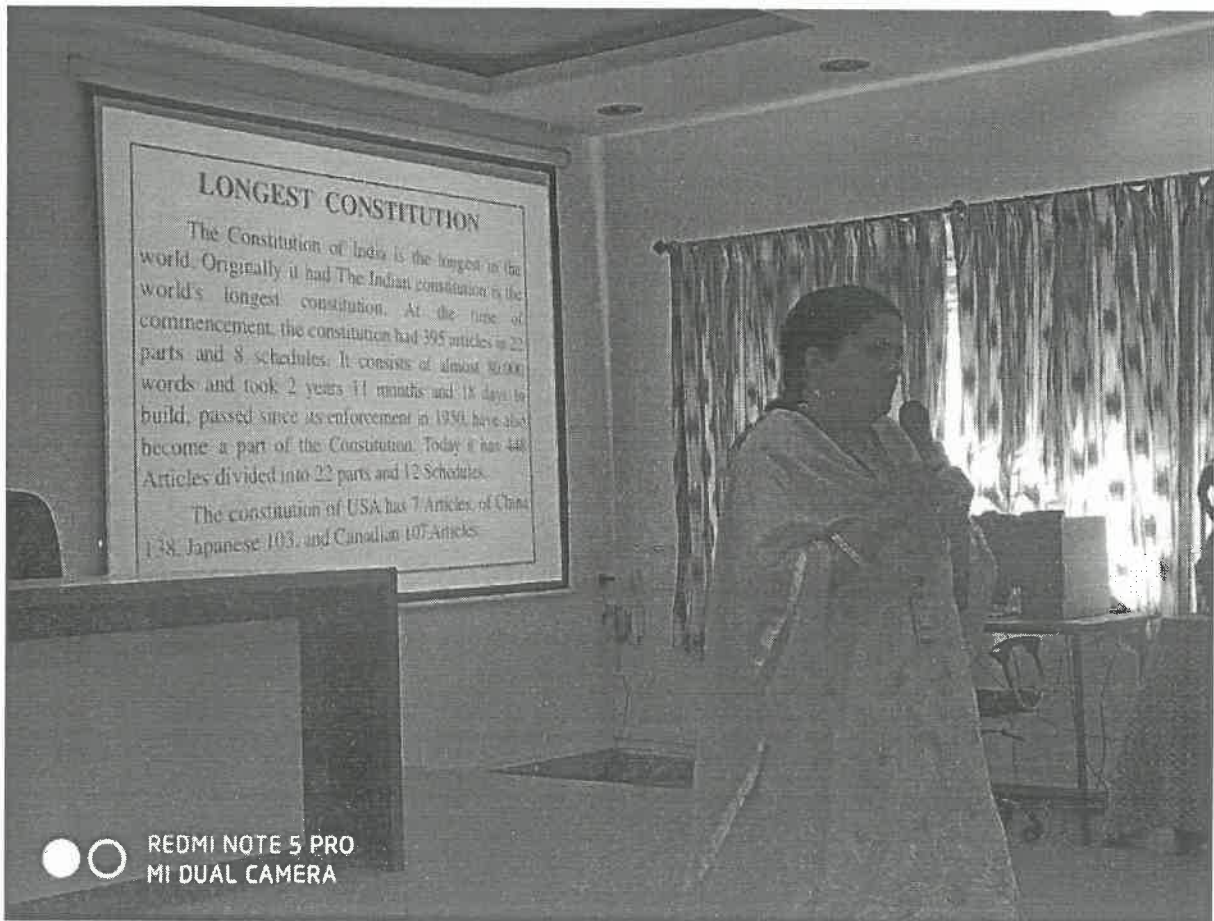
The constitution declares India a sovereign, socialist, secular, and democratic republic, assures its citizens justice, equality and liberty, and endeavours to promote fraternity. The original 1950 constitution is preserved in a helium-filled case at the Parliament House in New Delhi. The words "secular" and "socialist" were added to the preamble in 1976 during the Emergency.

We at S. B. Patil Institute of Management conducted a session on "Indian Constitution" for nonteaching staff of the Institute. Ms. Swaleha Mujawar, Asst. Teacher was invited to deliver a session on the topic of great importance. She told about the team involved in the making of the Indian Constitution. She also told that why the Indian constitution is considered as the longest constitution. She also explained briefly about the content of the Constitution. 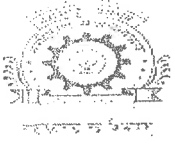

26<sup>th</sup> March 2021

Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi said about the Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav that the celebrations for India's 75 years of Independence should reflect the spirit of the country's freedom movement and showcase its achievements to the world since 1947.

The Indian independence movement was a series of historic events with the ultimate aim of ending the British rule in India. The movement spanned from 1857 to 1947.

The first nationalistic revolutionary movement for Indian independence emerged from Bengal. It later took root in the newly formed Indian National Congress with prominent moderate leaders seeking only their fundamental right to appear for Indian Civil Service examinations in British India, as well as more rights (economical in nature) for the people of the soil.

S. B. Patil Institute of Management invited Mr. Sagar Magar, Asst Prof, Department of History, Savitribai Phule Pune University to share his knowledge on the topic "India's Freedom Fight".

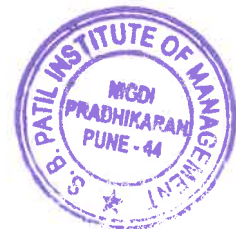


restored. It should culminate in the minds of the people that we belong to one nation, and we must be together to move forward as a strong independent nation.
