Feedback Analysis Report

- **Students Feedback:**

The students emphasized that the curriculum helped them to improve their decision making ability which is an outcome of opportunities provided by the institute to display their creativity during the program. Students strongly agreed the program has taught them to be a responsible citizen of the nation. They are satisfied with the infrastructural facilities provided by the institute. They agreed that improved creativity and innovativeness has helped them to develop their overall personality and are now ready to tackle difficult situations. They also voiced that the curriculum has assisted them in putting theory into practice to a certain extent. Students suggested on having more number of activities to develop various skill sets.

- **Teachers Feedback:**
