




Interpretation: Complete Syllabus coverage was always given priority at institute.




Interpretation: Almost all Teachers thoroughly and satisfactorily prepared for their classes.




Interpretation: Teachers were able to communicate very effectively during their classes, exercises and in other events.




Interpretation: Approach of teaching by Teachers has always been excellent and very good.




Interpretation: Internal evaluation process is always unbiased and fair by Teachers.






























Interpretation: Almost all teachers make effective use of various forms of ICT tools in their teaching and learning process.
